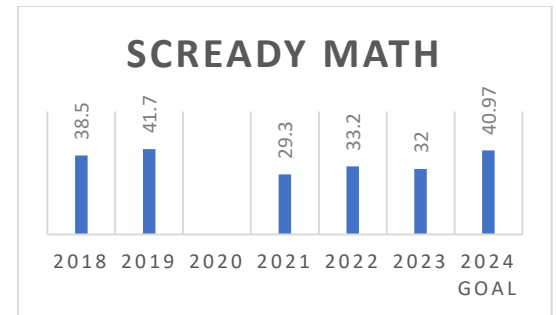
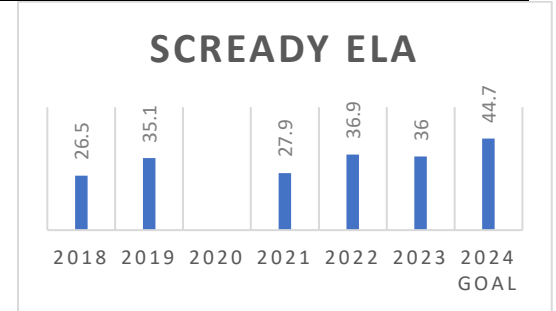
Our Goals

1. Increase family engagement by providing opportunities for families to interact with their children in the school atmosphere.
2. Increase students who scores exceeds or meets on SCREASY ELA from 34.16 % to 44.7% by creating a designated Intervention/Enrichment block, Lexia for all students, interventionists who serve all grades, and SAVVAS co-planning.
3. Increase students who scores exceeds or meets on SCREASY Math from 32.31 % to 40.97% by implementing guided math groups in all grades, attendance at all Title I math cohorts, DreamBox for all students, math interventionist, and utilization of the Title I math academic specialist.
