Parking decals will be sold at Greer High School during specific dates at the beginning of the year, during lunch shifts for the remainder of the year, and **the cost is \$30.00**. Please purchase your decal during the dates posted on the Greer High website or during lunch.

*****No decals will be issued to students with outstanding debts to the school.*****

The student parking lot is for use by Greer High School students who have registered their vehicles. A numbered registered decal will be provided and should be placed on the rearview mirror of your vehicle while on campus.

All students are required to take Alive at 25 and submit proof to the school the first time they request a parking pass. This is not something you have to do each year, only one time. Alive at 25 courses are offered throughout the community on a regular basis, online, and can be found at www.scaliveat25.com.

Students must park within the white lines of the parking space. Parking Lot Speed Limit: 5MPH. Violations of any parking regulations will result in fines, referrals or the suspension of parking privileges. *Students driving or riding to BCC or FAC will need an approved application from those centers. Those applications are available at BCC or FAC.*
