Bring your photo ID and one of the following:

- a Medicaid card for each student
- a letter of free/reduced lunch eligibility from the Greenville County School District
- an EBT card for the family

You will fill out a short application and then school supplies will be given out on a first-come-first-served basis to those who qualify. Supplies are limited and only available while supplies last.
