



GREENVILLE COUNTY SCHOOLS ATHLETICS STUDENT-ATHLETE SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

Purpose of Scholarship:

There are six (6) scholarships in the amount of \$2,500 each available to six (6) Greenville County Schools Student-Athletes.

Each scholarship recognizes the commitment to building a better graduate by Greenville County Schools and Greenville Automotive Group by developing the workforce of tomorrow and supporting opportunities for students to learn and grow as well as provide preferred employment opportunities subject to availability, qualifications, references, and possibly other criteria post-graduation within the automotive field at one of the four (4) Greenville Automotive Group dealerships, including: Lexus of Greenville, Nissan of Greenville, Toyota of Greenville and Jaguar-Land Rover of Greenville. Greenville County Schools high school student-athletes who have shown commitment to academics, athletics and the positive influence on others are eligible to apply.

Criteria:

1. Applicant must demonstrate the following:
 - A. Earned a minimum of a 2.0 grade point average;
 - B. Earned a letter in (1) Varsity sport for at least two years; OR (2) Varsity sports for at least one year;
 - C. Interest in acceptance to Greenville Technical College, or similar higher education or trade school with enrollment on a full-time basis beginning no later than August 2019;
 - D. Acceptable discipline records;
 - E. Demonstrates exemplary leadership qualities and characteristics.
2. Applicant must complete and submit attached scholarship application, along with supporting materials, no later than 4:00 p.m. on April 1, 2019.
3. Applicant must provide a letter of recommendation from high school teacher, guidance counselor, coach or administrator.
4. Applicant's high school principal and athletic director must sign the application to ensure that the academic and athletic information submitted is accurate.

Applicant must attend a member school of Greenville County Schools and be in compliance with all rules and regulations set forth as a full-time student.

Scholarship committee consisting of school district and automotive industry personnel will review applications and inform successful recipients by **April 22, 2019**.
