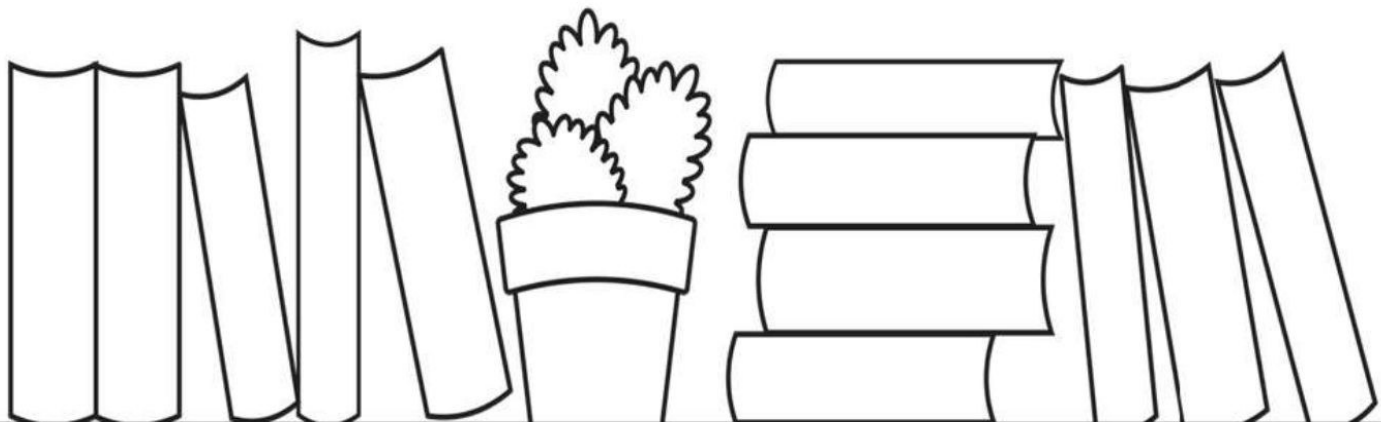
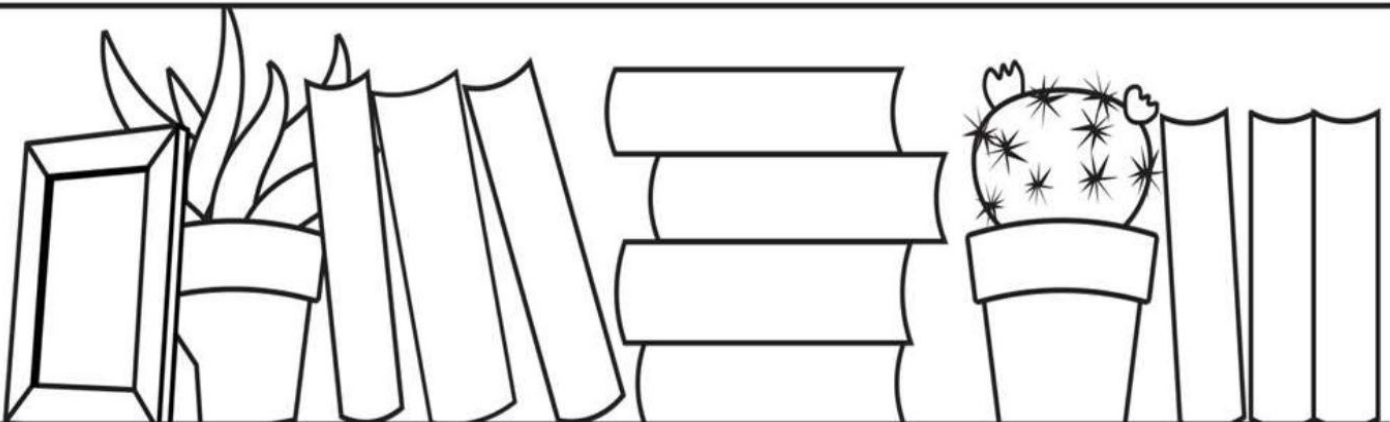
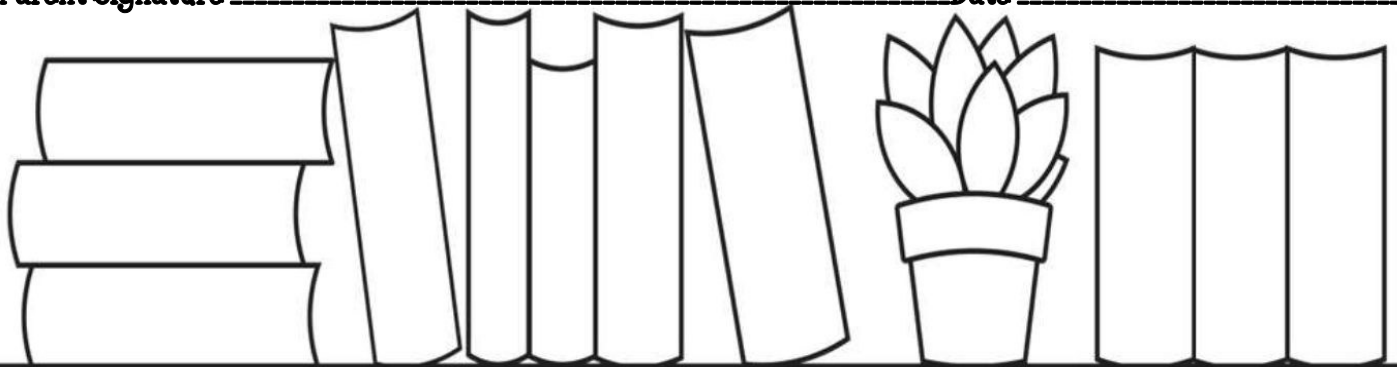
Bethel Summer Reading
