**RE:** Restorative Practices Regional Training

The Office of Student Intervention Services will host *Introduction to Restorative Practices* and *Using Circles Effectively* for administrators and educators currently employed in South Carolina public schools. Research indicates that the successful and sustained implementation of restorative practices positively impacts student behavior and school climate.

During the two-day regional workshops, facilitated by South Carolina Department of Education trainers certified by the International Institute for Restorative Practices, participants will learn practical strategies for building and maintaining healthy relationships. Because of the nature of the training, each workshop will be limited to 40 participants on a first-come-first-served basis. Although there is **no cost to participate** in the workshops, **registration is required.**
