

MIDDLE SCHOOL ATHLETIC EVENTS

For all Greenville County Schools middle school athletic events (except football – see high school requirements for 7-8th grade D-team football), the following requirements are in place to ensure the safety of all attendees:

Middle school students and older must have a school-issued ID to enter a middle school athletic event alone; otherwise, they must be accompanied by an adult 19 years old or older.

Please note that students who are not picked up immediately following the conclusion of an athletic event may not be able to attend future athletic events.

Elementary students and younger must be accompanied by an adult 19 years old or older to every athletic event.

No loitering in any area; all fans need to sit in the home or visitor stands during the event.

Not following any of the rules outlined above will result in removal from the event without a refund.

HIGH SCHOOL ATHLETIC EVENTS

For all Greenville County Schools high school athletic events (including 7-8th grade D-team football), the following requirements are in place to ensure the safety of all attendees:

Middle school students and younger must be accompanied by an adult 19 years old or older to every high school athletic event (including 7-8th grade D-team football).

High school students must have a school-issued ID to enter an athletic event. alone; otherwise, they must be accompanied by an adult 19 years old or older.

Please note that students who are not picked up immediately following the conclusion of an athletic event may not be able to attend future athletic events.

No loitering in any area; all fans need to sit in the home or visitor stands during the event.

Not following any of the rules outlined above will result in removal from the event without a refund.

SOME ADDITIONAL REMINDERS

There is a clear bag policy for GCS events. Individuals attending an athletic event may be subject to search.
