Dear Parent/Student,

Regular school attendance is important to the academic success of every student. On our block schedule, students are allowed to miss 5 days for each semester class and 3 days for quarter classes. Absences above this limit **violate SC Compulsory Attendance law** and put the student in danger of losing credit. \*\* Please note that although we will make every effort to inform students when they have exceeded the allowed number of absences, **it is ultimately the student's responsibility to keep track of his or her absences.** Absences can be tracked through the student and parent portals. This year Greenville High School will offer Seat-Time Recovery for those students who are passing their classes yet slightly over in terms of days for attendance based on the following schedule. Seat time Recovery allows students to recover 1 absence by serving 1.5 hours of seat time and must be served in 3 hour increments. Students should see Mrs. Johnson during lunch to sign up for individual sessions. The cost is \$15.00/3 hours and \$30.00/6 hours. **Students must pay BEFORE they can serve!! You may only sign up and pay during your assigned lunch time. No students will be allowed to attend seat time if they are not on the schedule.**

**You can begin signing up AT LUNCH!**

**When attending seat time: no food deliveries (bring food with you), no late entry, no refunds, and no rescheduling dates.**
