FORMAT

The **Edgenuity** platform will be used for grade level math and ELA support only. These modules are online and require a school-issued chromebook and internet access.

ALL Assessments must be proctored **in person**.

Students are expected to attend summer school in person at their cluster site where certified teachers are available to assist them.

In person support is available Monday - Thursday from 8:30 AM - 12:30 PM.

Course work is self-paced. Students must have all work completed by June 25, but may be able to finish coursework earlier.

ONLY school identified GCS students may participate in the middle school remediation program.
