

Led by Greenville County School's 2020 Principal of the Year, Monaview Elementary has become a leading example in growing all students. With a strong belief that "Every Student Counts, Every Moment Matters," we have earned and maintained an Excellent report card rating with the highest student progress in South Carolina.

Monaview Elementary is the 2018 recipient of the William T. Wylie VALUED Lives Award for School Excellence in Diversity, sponsored by the Greenville Chamber and Riley Institute. This honor is bestowed upon outstanding K-12 schools in the Upstate region who are meeting central qualities of diversity, and Monaview is the first Greenville County elementary school to do so.

Our school's faculty and staff have taken great strides to create and maintain an atmosphere and learning environment where everyone is welcomed, valued, and supported.

With the highest Hispanic population in Greenville County Schools of 76% and with almost 12% of students having lived in the U.S. for two or less years, Monaview strives to meet the needs of its increasingly diverse community.

To encourage positive self-image for students, we have created a hall of mirror with inspiring messages about what staff members see in their students.

Monaview provides professional development for staff which focuses on family engagement and implements poverty simulations, book studies, and involvement with organizations like Public Education Partners.

We have created a Parent Resource Room to give parents access to computers, programs, and technology like Rosetta Stone. With projects like Jumpstarting Literacy for Internationals, which provide books to support students with limited English abilities, and We've Got Character, which provide character development books in the classroom library to help students learn important social and emotional skills, the school makes an effort to increase diversity of learning materials. Monaview is an excellent example of how schools should support #diversity and offer engaging educational opportunities to all students!
