

## Walker/Bike Rider Permission Form

- Students must have parental (or legal guardian) permission to walk/bike to and from school. Permission forms must be completed each school year.
- Students in kindergarten or first grade must be accompanied by an older sibling in the 4th or 5th grade or have a parent/legal guardian meet the student at the school's designated location with the applicable tag number. Any kindergarten or first grade walker who does not have a designee or parent/legal guardian with the applicable tag, will be returned to the school, at which time a parent, legal guardian, or other designee will be required to pick the child up from the school's front office.
- In the event of rain or cold weather, walkers/bike riders will still walk/bike to their destination. However, in the event of severe inclement weather (i.e., tornado warning), walkers/bike riders will remain inside until it is safe to exit the school building; this may result in a late dismissal.
- Students who are walkers/bike riders must observe pedestrian and walker safety guidelines, including the directions of any crossing guard, and are encouraged to use sidewalks as available.
- If your child's transportation arrangements change, please provide written notice of the change to your child's homeroom teacher or, in case of an emergency, call the school's front office.
