Hello 5th Grade Sterling School Program Parents/Guardians! As your child prepares to transition to middle school, we want to ensure you feel equipped and informed to make the best decision for their future. Greenville County offers several options, including Choice Schools, magnet programs, and your home-based assigned middle school. We encourage you to explore these opportunities and participate in the Choice School selection process, which begins November 21, 2024, and runs through December 6, 2024. School Choice

Greenville County Schools is a "choice" district, offering quality schools at all levels across the school system. Approximately 14% of the school system's 78,000 students attend school on choice.

Students are assigned to a school (home-based) based on the address where their custodial parent/guardian resides. School assignments are listed by subdivision/multi-family dwelling and home address using the "Find Your Schools" link below. Parents may request that their children attend another school through Change in Assignment Choice (CIA) and/or applying to the school system's Magnet Academies.

The district's eleven magnet academies of accelerated learning offer unique educational choices to the students of Greenville County to meet their individual needs. The academic program of each magnet academy offers a theme or focus that is designed to give students an opportunity to explore a special interest, gift, talent or skill. Change in Assignment Lottery Process

Highlights: Scan for link to complete information for all grades. *Note, this process does not affect Dr. Phinnize J. Fisher Middle School, per its Population Plan. In addition, CTC middle school students are solely selected using Gifted and Talented criteria.

Choice Lottery Window: Nov 21 - Dec 6, 2024

- Visit your 1st choice school to complete a choice form (not online).
- Submit up to 3 school choices.
- Receive a copy with a number to check lottery results later.

Lottery Results Posted by Feb 12, 2025

- Check results on the GCS website using your choice form number.
- Results show the numerical order of applicants, not assignments.

Notification by Mar 31, 2025

• Receive a letter with your student's assignment or waitlist number.

Waiting List

- Students not assigned will be placed on a waitlist.
- Assignments from the waitlist continue until 8 days into the 2025-26 school year.
