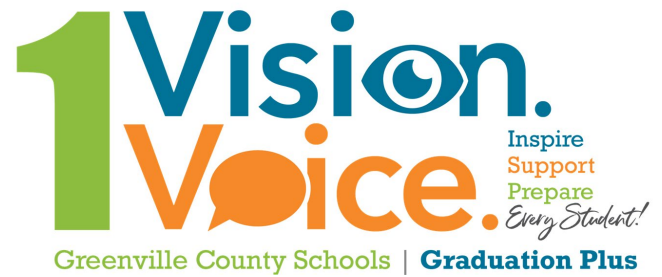


GCS Twilight School
